Early Stage East was founded in 1998 as a non-profit organization and has grown from a single-day venture capital fair to a year-round series of events. Our events showcase entrepreneurs from up and down the East Coast in order for them to effectively obtain venture capital and successfully start break-away businesses. Early Stage East is geographically the largest venture conference specifically for early stage companies.

The Early Stage East 2005 Venture Conference held on May 11&12 at the Hyatt Regency Philadelphia at Penn's Landing attracted 400+ investors, entrepreneurs, and service providers and more than \$6 billion dollars!

What we do

The mainstay of Early Stage East is our venture capital conferences. The Early Stage East Conference, in the spring, features early stage companies focused on information technology, enterprise software and internet technology. This year, companies specializing in chemicals and advanced materials, manufacturing technology, nanotechnology, medical instruments and devices, industrial biotechnology and electronic materials will be presenting at the conference.

Early Stage East significantly aided our capital raising efforts. We attended last spring's show, where we met a large number of top-tier investors. With such a variety of potential partners at the show, we were able to find investors whose portfolio and expertise were a match for our products and funding needs.

Early Stage East also hosts the industry-specific Bio-Life-Tech Conference which focuses on the fields of biotechnology, life science, pharmaceuticals, nanotechnology and the related instrumentation and technologies that support these industries. Early Stage East, based in Wilmington, DE, focuses on entrepreneurs and venture capitalists from New England to the Carolinas attracting attention to areas with peak activity in the industries featured at the conferences.

Who attends ESE Events

Early Stage East events attracts a wide audience of institutional and venture capital investors. The Early Stage East 2005 Venture Conference in Philadelphia, PA represented a 31% increase in investor participation from the previous year. Early Stage East 2005 highlighted 24 emerging companies on the East Coast attracting more than 75 venture funds and financial institutions to the conference.
